



INFORMATION DATA SHEET QUALITY DIFFERENCES FOR SEA CONTAINERS (LAST UPDATED: 06/2021)

Welcome to MERCONLOG!

This information data sheet provides you with important information about the quality differences for sea containers.

Other competitors divide the quality of their containers into grade categories from A to D. Since these categories are non-binding and not uniform, we use the generally recognised quality terms that are customary in the industry:

- ▶ One Trip
- ▶ Cargo Worthy (IICL)
- ▶ Cargo Worthy (CW)
- ▶ Wind- and Watertight (WWT)
- ▶ As Is

1. One Trip

One Trip containers, also called "One-Way" because they are usually only one sea voyage old when they are shipped to their port of destination after they were manufactured, may show signs of wear and tear due to use and transport, have a CSC plate valid for 5 years, are inspected, wind- and watertight, and are suitable for intermodal transport.

2. Cargo Worthy (IICL):

Used containers which are repaired according to the IICL-Standard of the International Institute of Container Lessors (iicl.org) may show signs of wear and tear due to use and transport, have a CSC plate valid for at least 12 months, are inspected, wind- and watertight, and are suitable for intermodal transport.

3. Cargo Worthy (CW):

Used containers that show signs of wear due to age, use and transport, have a CSC plate valid for at least 12 months, are inspected, wind- and watertight and suitable for intermodal transport.

4. Wind- and Watertight (WWT):

Used containers that show signs of wear due to age, use and transport, are inspected, wind- and watertight, but do not have a valid CSC plate.

5. As Is

Used containers that may have minor, moderate or severe damage, are not tested wind- and watertight and do not have a valid CSC plate.
